### Howmany delegates can an Intergroup vote to elect?

Each Intergroup is entitled to send one delegate for every three meetings/groups and one additional delegate for any portion thereof.

# What if my group does not belong to an Intergroup?

Groups not affiliated with an Intergroup are also eligible to send a delegate using a similar system. If there are between one and three groups not affiliated with an Intergroup, those one, two, or three meetings may elect one delegate collectively. If there are more than three, those groups again may collectively send one delegate for every three meetings and one additional delegate for any portion thereof.

#### Are the costs a delegate incurs reimbursable? What are the procedures for an election?

Delegate election is done the way any other business is conducted at your local group or Intergroup. Some Intergroups reimburse delegates for a portion of the conference expenses, but both of these aspects of delegate service are outside the scope of NAWS in keeping with our 4th Tradition. Delegate expenses may *be* tax deductible.
